Changes:

- o The list wasn't updated when the url was changed. Fixed.

- o Added advanced option to hide the url icons from the lists.

- o New API function: Rainlendar\_QuitApplication()

- o Few performance improvements.

- o Added more checks to the new calendar wizard so that you don't accidentally leave out the name of the file or the extension.

- o Removed unnecessary warning if copy/move was cancelled in the Manager.

- o Yearly recurring events which cross the year end were not shown correctly. Fixed.

- o Dismissing a Google calendar alarm will remove the reminders from the single events.

- o Tasks couldn't be set as completed until the due date had passed. Fixed.

- o Weekly recurring tasks which didn't have start time defined were shown incorrectly in the calendar. Fixed.

- o Tooltips were not shown correctly on non-Windows platforms when On Desktop settings was used in multi-monitor environment. Fixed.

- o The RTM plugin reads just the incomplete tasks from the server.

Weirdly, the first "test task" I deleted in RTM DID delete from my Rainlendar ics, but no subsequent tasks have successfully deleted. Hmmmm....

I'm going to try a re-install of the beta to see if I might have botched it.

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Okay, I have reinstalled, and futzed around, and I think I located the bug, if that's what it is-- (deleted this text because upon further investigation it isn't accurate; revised text follows--)

If I add many tasks to RTM, and then mark them all as complete in RTM, all but one task will become marked complete in Rainlendar. I have not been able to figure out which task doesn't sync properly-- first entered, last entered, with tags, with no tags. So far it seems kind of random. This task remains in the Rainlendar list until I mark it complete in Rainlendar.

Here's the interesting part-- so far, as long as I LEAVE that improperly synced task in Rainlendar, I am able to sync all other tasks with RTM successfully. :S

Do let me know if you can repeat this, anybody. And, especially, if it's something that can be fixed.

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Can you give exact steps how to reproduce this. Here's what I tried:

- Create new RTM calendar to Rainlendar
- Create 10 new tasks in RTM's web site
- Refresh Rainlendar so that it reads them from RTM (the tasks were shown correctly in the to do list)
- Set all 10 tasks to completed one by one in the RTM's web site
- Refresh Rainlendar

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The result was that all the task were removed from the Rainlendar's to do list like they should.

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Hi-- thanks so much for looking into this. So I did just what you said:

- created ten events in RTM
- refreshed RTM calendar in Rainlendar, all events appeared
- deleted events in RTM-- in this case, I completed one event and then refreshed, then deleted a couple more, and then refreshed. Every single event showed complete in Rainlendar except the last one.
- added three new events to RTM (now I have four total)
- refreshed calendar in Rainlendar, four total RTM events appear
- completed two events in RTM
- refreshed calendar in Rainlendar-- four total events appear!
- checked RTM-- all four events are back in the calendar, marked as uncomplete.

I'm attaching my .ini file, just in case you can find something in it. I'm happy to send you any other files that would help (.ics, etc).

One idea I had: when I upgraded to the beta version, I think I kept my original .ini, because I didn't want to have to go through all the settings again. Would that have done it? :S

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Three ways to crash Rainlendar on Mac OSX

- in the Skin settings remove the tray icon, refresh, right click on the Rainlendar icon in the dock -> crash
- in the Skin settings change the scaling factor to 120 of any item, hit ok -> crash (might not crash on the first item, but crashes on next for sure)
- install the widget addons, enable the weather widget (without changing anything of its settings), refresh, works fine. Now change the weather location and it wil crash, sometimes before you can hit ok.

I only switched last week from Windows to Mac, if I can help with debugging, just tell me what to do.

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After much futzing, and multiple clean reinstalls of the beta, I think I have found the problem: when I installed Remember the Milk, I did not select a list, left it blank to include all lists. Once I selected my main list (inbox) the behavior stopped. At least, as of now. WHOOO HOOO.

So, for future RTM users, you must select at least one list in order for tasks to sync properly.

Rainy, just for my own interest, I'd love to know if you can repeat this with your setup-- ie, remove everything from the "lists" category in RTM calendar setup, and see if you get the re-appearing tasks.
