so all that stuff about small letters - do you mean filenames in linux are case sensitive, and the case of the filename should match the case of the xml? if so, then sure, i can fix that easy enough.

i have also considered decreasing the font size. in fact, i think the whole thing is too big, but the thought of shrinking the

graphics and adjusting the whole skin is a bit daunting. oh, if only Rainlendar had a skinning engine like CD Art Display :woohoo:

i have no idea what Chromophore means, but i'll consider adding a 2-calendar version. i was also thinking about just a calendar with a toggleable events/tasks list. but i'm a bit burned out on this now, so i'll come back to it in a few days.

I have unpacked your skin and packed the folders (images and xml) and file (skin.xml) in a zip-file. Then I change the zip file in r2skin file. Now it is possible to install the skin like wrote in the faq. How can I install skins or languages? --> To install new skins (.r2skin) you can just drag and drop the file over one of the Rainlendar's windows and it will be installed automatically. In Windows you can install the skin also just by double clicking it.

if you want to do it yourself, it's quite easy. just open up the elements.xml file in notepad, and change the value of font.calendar to whatever you want it to be. the other font sizes can be changed there too.
