You can create a background for your calendar by adding an image element as the first item of the <window> in calendar.xml. Something like this:

```
<image id="Calendar.background" element="bitmap.background.calendar" origin1="TOP-LEFT" x1="0" y1="0"
origin2="BOTTOM-RIGHT" x2="0" y2="0" scaling="STRETCH" margins="0,0,0,0" />
```

(remember to define the bitmap.background.calendar in elements.xml)

The icons can be removed from the calendar if you remove the appearances from the elements.xml which have target="1". Do this only for the icons or otherwise you'll lose also the colors from the numbers.
