Changes:

- o Fixed text wrapping when the area gets really small.
- o Column order in the manager can be changed by dragging (only supported on Windows though).
- o It's now possible to define any file for the alarm. All non-audio files are executed instead of played back.
- o Changed the way Google alarms are defined. You now have option to always use alert, the Google's methods or the default Google notifications.
- o Added advanced setting to delay the network access on startup.
- o Category filters didn't work for translated category names. Fixed.
- o Retry if proxy fails setting didn't work with RTM. Fixed.
- o Added grid calendar for the Chromophore skin.
- o Added navigation arrows to the day and week views in the Shadow4 skin.
- o The first uncompleted task is now shown from RTM (previously it was the last one).
- o Changes to the window positioning on Mac. The dialogs stay now always on top since previously they could open behind other windows.

mailto: is a workaround but adds text in the alarm and lists display, http:\etc.com does nothing. Could you please have something like %URL% and %EMAIL% that works like a desktop shortcut and open the browser or mail respectively but displays nothing but the link itself when the list or alarm is visible?

%URL%ibm.com would look like ibm.com but when clicked opens the browser to ibm.com

%EMAIL%send.me@email.com looks like send.me@email.com but open the email client to TO: send.me@email.com

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I have now changed it back to Custom and it works. I didn't remember that it could be changed with a right click but eventually found it after you mentioned it. Could you please add this to the options?

I'll see if those could be added to the window's settings.

Can you at least add to to the options so it can be manually changed? Also if you were to have a routine to check when the program starts it could move it for backups as well. A simple rainlendar2.ini that shows where everything is in the startup location and a new ini that just has the settings in the user defined location would solve this. That simple routine on startup I mentioned could strip it out at startup and create the new files.

Yes, that could be possible but I'm not sure if it's really worth it. Most users don't even have to know where the settings are stored and if you really want to change the location you can already do that.

Actually the numbers are fine, the week day abbreviations overlap each other and I cant figure out how to make the font smaller in the skin.

The fonts are usually defined in the elements.xml file so you should check from there.

Could you please have something like %URL% and %EMAIL% that works like a desktop shortcut and open the browser or mail respectively but displays nothing but the link itself when the list or alarm is visible?

Hmmm... I could add the wiki url support for the Url-field. I'll see if that's possible.
