I've used Rainlendar for months, but some days ago an odd glitch has appeared: the date in Rainlendar's icon in the system tray does not update when the system current date changes and always shows the date when Rainlendar current session was started :ohmy:

However the calendar on the Desktop shows the correct date (see the attached image).  
Restarting Rainlendar has not solve the problem.
