Changes:

- o Switched back to wxWidgets 2.8.
- o Setting a task completed will change the status correctly on Outlook too.
- o The url field for events and tasks can now use wiki style link formatting.
- o The todo list settings (e.g. the sorting orders) can be changed now from the options too.
- o Added support for "exevents" for the xml format skins.
- o Added a special "" category which hides the event/task from other windows except the alarm.
- o Fixed a crash bug when the calendar is reloaded at the same time the user chose an event from the menu.
- o The year, month and day in the keywords can be replaced with YYYY, MM and DD to represent the next date from today. E.g. "".
- o Added possibility to define the height and width for the Shadow4's calendar window from the settings.

For some reason Google returns zero events when reading them after suspend but manual refresh does fix the problem.

Yeah, the default notifications are defined. I also tried using "Default Google notifications", but that didn't work either.

That's what I do :

Create a recurring event (yearly)

Enable the reminder on that event

Save it into my Google Calendar (not the main one, though)

It seems that it doesn't work when creating a yearly recurring event. I have tried creating a monthly recurring event and it worked.

I've never worked with an .ics file, but I had a look at how Google and Rainlendar define a yearly recurring event :

Google :

RRULE:FREQ=YEARLY;WKST=SU

Rainlendar :

RRULE:FREQ=YEARLY;BYMONTHDAY=3;BYMONTH=3

Maybe Google can't load that specific line and 'crashes'. Vague theory, I know , but maybe it'll help :D
