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I figured out what was missing from rainlendar2.ini. Further down the file, there is a section where calendars are listed. This must be updated, like so:

```
Calendars]
```

```

Name=Google-kalenteri
```

```

```

ReadOnly=0
```

```
SuppressAlarms=0
```

VisualCategory=
```

Now I have a working calendar! :cheer: The window problem remains, however.

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
