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## Dates for recurring tasks do not update in To-Do

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Hi,

I have just started using Rainlendar and would like to know if there is any way to create a recurring task in the To-Do list where the due date would update automatically each time one occurrence of the event has passed by.

For example, I want to set an alarm for a task that I need to complete daily at 9:00pm.  
I want to repeat this event daily.

I have set this up using the "New Task" from the context menu in To-Do window. However, the "due date" is always fixed to the due date that I used to create the task. It doesn't update automatically to the next due date once the time for the event has passed.

I am aware that I can create a "New event" from the context menu of Events window, but I don't like this since it fills the Event window with too many events which overshadow other one-time important events. This would be even more of a nuisance if I wanted to add 2 or 3 daily recurring events.

I'd like to use the To-Do list since it's much "cleaner" because the event is listed only once. However, the only problem is that the due date doesn't update to the next due date. It is always fixed.

Is it possible to have the due date update itself automatically in the To-Do window? If not, could this feature be implemented? Thanks.

Solution is simple:

1) Add an option (tick) to enable/disable "display next due date". Or two separate options, one for displaying next due date and one for displaying start due date.

2) Same could be said about the events list. There could be an option where user could enter the number of future entries to display in the Events window. We could have options such as "none" (same as hidden), "all" or manually enter the "number of entries" to display.

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Only the current due date is visible. You can complete a task by clicking the bullet next to the item (this depends on the skin though) and the due date will be moved forward.
