
Rainlendar 2.0.1 build 30

Build 30 can be downloaded from here:

Windows: Rainlendar-2.0.1.b30.zip

Linux: Rainlendar-2.0.1.b30.tar.bz2

This is beta version! It has not been tested.

The offline copy feature in the network calendars requires some additional testing still. I suggest that you make a backup of your events (also on the server) before you enable it from Options->Calendars.

You should also note that even if you are able to add and modify events while off-line it's not possible to delete the them without the network connection. Or well, you can delete an event but it will appear again when the connection is available and the event is read back from the online version.

The list of changes:

- 10 Dec 2006

- o Alarm sound set for an event was not played. Fixed.
- o Added "Keep offline copy" option to network calendar.
- o Fixed a hang when a recurring task was set to completed.
- o Pre and post days were shown always in the Dec-Jan. Fixed.
- o The Private-checkbox didn't work. Fixed.
- o Tooltips shouldn't pop up anymore if the menu is open.
- o Improvements to the legacy skin support.

Still getting this bug with this build rainy:

This is a strange bug i'm getting with build 29.

If I manually type the time in when creating an event (or if I select 9.00pm but change it myself to 9.15pm) the time changes by itself from the afternoon to the morning. Because of this if I try to make an event starting at 9.00am until 2.15pm the end time is not displayed (because it's changed to 2.15am which would be before the start time).

Anyone else having this problem?

EDIT: I've just switched back to build 27 (I can't use 2.0.1 because of the cleartype issue) and the bug is not there.

I should mention this is for any time which I manually change (not just for quarter past the hour)

sjmclean: The changes done in the offline file are automatically synced to the online version as soon as the connection is up again. The problem with the event deletion is that at the moment the deleted events are completely removed from the ics file. And when the online file is synced with the offline contents the program assumes that the deleted event is a new one and adds it back to the offline file.

Alf: The build script always repacks the skin even if there haven't been any modifications in it. I try to add at least all the major changes to the changes.txt but minor things might not be included (this also applies to the application itself). I suggest to make a copy of the skin if you change it so that it's not accidentally overwritten.
