There is no rss feed for those since they don't really update that often. The pot file gets updated only after a release (maybe few times to fix the found problems) and the widget addon's updates are usually tied to the beta releases if I make changes which affect it but that is kept separate from the official addon until the new version is released.

Yes, the file widget strings seem to be missing. I'll add those.

Well, this isn't the best way, but is "any" :laugh:

I've made a very tiny program with VB6 (works in WinXP SP3) to check and replace (if needed) the three files i know: .pot, widget and languages.

The settings.ini file is quite simple:

sourcefolder: the folder where the files to compare are

destfolder: the folder where the new files will be downloaded (could be the same as sourcefolder if you don't want to know which are the changes)

file: each one of the urls

(those lines can't be reorder. "sourcefolder" and "destfolder" need to be before "file")

And finally, with "checker h" the program runs in the background.
