### Changes:

- o The category filters are now case insensitive.
- o Month view didn't show multiple events on the same day correctly. Fixed.
- o Weekly recurring events did not take into account the interval when calculating the end date.
- o Restoring a backup didn't apply the settings. Fixed.
- o Added possibility to create custom categories for skins which support them.
- o "Custom category icon path" in advanced options can be used to define a folder for custom icons.
- o Added "Open containing folder" for the skin's context menu in the options dialog.
- o Added %HF as header format code which will be replaced with the default header text.

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Rainy, I've tried using the Shadow4 addon r2skin file you linked for download in your build 90 to get weather functioning again, but when I try to install it (on beta build 92, 90, etc.) it errors saying: "Unable to install the skin! The skin doesn't contain the "skin.xml" file. Are you sure this is an xml format Rainlendar skin? This us using Mac OS 10.6. I rename the file type from .zip to .r2skin in getinfo to make sure it's in the correct file type. If I unzip it, it does have the xml files in there. Can you provide assistance, Rainlendar is how I know what to wear!

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Suggestion and bugs? for the new "Categories..." option:

- \* Show some default name for small and large icon (this isn't so difficult because in the original skin are the names)
- \* An option to none icon?
- \* "Font color" always shows "Blue" (the first element in the combo list) and not the choosed font color (same in schedule font). Besides, if you want to go back to blue color you can't, because no change is detected.
- \* I don't know if is possible, but, after doing the categories option, could there be an option to show ordinal number in any category instead of anniversary and birthday only? (in build 90, i clear all info in Anniversary just for show those numbers)

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\* Show some default name for small and large icon (this isn't so difficult because in the original skin are the names) Yes, the Chromophore skin should have a default value defined for the icons since it uses one. I'll fix that.

\* An option to none icon?

There is one but it's visible only when no icon is selected by default. I have to fix that.

\* I don't know if is possible, but, after doing the categories option, could there be an option to show ordinal number in any category instead of anniversary and birthday only? (in build 90, i clear all info in Anniversary just for show those numbers)

This is in my backlog so it will probably be implemented eventually. You can also use the keywords if you want the event to calculate the days/months/years automatically.

\* Not all colors are translated (only blue, brown, cyan, green, red and yellow). These color (except blue) aren't showed in the calendar, but black, white, pink... yes. (maybe this is same problem as evanade has)

The colors which are not translated are new strings. It's not advised to use the category editor at the moment in any other language than in English.

\* Still don't understand. How priority works?

Anniversary: Black (pri=1). Game: Light grey (pri=2) -----> shows Light grey

Anniversary: Black (pri=2). Game: Light grey (pri=1) -----> shows Black

... or so it should work but the priority value doesn't seem to be set correctly for the custom categories. I'll check that.

Note also that recurrence affects the priority so that less frequently repeating events get a boost in their priority value.

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evanade, the property grid probably doesn't support such editor which would show just the icons in a grid so I would have to create one myself. I'll see how much work it would require.

The color dialog doesn't support alpha (at least not on Windows) so it's not possible to define it in the UI. But since the values from the categories.ini are just replaced in the skin you should be able to define the alpha for the text by editing the ini file manually.

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
