When I start Rainlendar in Fedora 13 I get the following message:

```
./rainlendar2: /usr/lib/libcurl.so.4: no version information available (required by ./rainlendar2)
```

In my system /usr/lib/libcurl.so.4 is a soft link pointing to /usr/lib/libcurl.so.4.2.0. And the version of libcurl told by yum is 7.20.1-3.fc13

Here's the versions of the libcurl on the OS where the binaries are compiled:

32bit: 7.16.4-2ubuntu1.1 (libcurl.so.4.0.0)

64bit: 7.18.0-1ubuntu2.2 (libcurl.so.4.0.1)

I would imagine though that newer versions should work too.

i got the same error messages on a gentoo system.

```

```

I have the following versions installed:

net-misc/curl 7.21.4

media-libs/libpng 1.4.8

I tried the pro and the lite version. Although the beta version. All the same. Any ideas?
