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Rainy, I've noticed a bug in the month view calendar. If you have a task that appears on the calendar and try to edit the date/time in the calendar, it automatically sets dates and times to 31/12/1969 at 5:59pm, even when it is displaying correctly in the month view. If you edit the details in the to do window, it pulls up correctly. This does not affect actual events.
