The Chromophore doesn't show week numbers but at least the default calendar window in Shadow4 does. You can enable/disable them from the window's settings (go to options->skins, click advanced button, select the calendar window and click settings).

The Shadow skin has always been transparent. If you want a skin with a solid background you can use e.g. the Chromophore skin or search one from one of the skin libraries.
