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## Convert ini-format skins to xml-format

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Here's a script which converts the old ini format skins to the new xml format.

### Requirements:

- Rainlendar 2.8 b96 or newer (get it from the beta forum)
- Python 2.x (Python 3.x might not run the script so make sure you download the 2.x version).

### Usage:

- Download and install Python (if you use Linux or Mac you probably have it already)
- Copy the script to the same folder where the skin's ini files are located
- Run the script either by double clicking it (on Windows) or from the command line (python ConvertSkin.py)

The script will create a new file called skin.xml into the same folder. If there is only one ini file in the folder everything will be written to the skin.xml file. If there are multiple files the script will create a separate xml file for each of them and include them from the skin.xml file.

Rainlendar will try to find the skin.xml file first from the folder so after you've run the script you can refresh Rainlendar, go to options and choose the newly created skin (the old ini format version is not accessible anymore so if you were using the skin Rainlendar will revert to the default skin). If you want to go back to the ini format skin or try the conversion again you can just delete the skin.xml file from the folder.

If you find a skin which cannot be converted with the script but works fine in Rainlendar2 please post a download link to it.

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Thanks for the script but it has errors:

In convertInisToXml function, in else part, you call parseIniFile(iniFile, skin, "", True) but iniFile variable doesn't exist. I changed this by iniFiles.

With this change, the script creates the xml file but incomplete. It shows several errors:

I'm on Ubuntu Linux 10.04 32 bits with python 2.6.

The created xml file is unusable.

First of all, i know nothing about Python, but yes about programming, so, here's my help. There are some problem which can be solved but simply i don't know how.

I think that your correction was correct about iniFiles

In the first case, the SimpleNote skin (<http://www.customize.org/rainlendar/skins/35411>), i'm not sure, but i think that the problem is the skin doesn't have a event list window. And that is "TypeError: cannot serialize None (type NoneType)" If you comment the CreateEventList line, you will have troubles again, because CreateToDoList checks for the header in the eventlist (which again, doesn't exist) If you comment both lines, the calendar will be showed.

With the second skin (<http://www.customize.org/rainlendar/skins/69058>) the error is clear: if you look the Glossy.ini file you will find there is a missing square bracket in "Profile 5" section (the \r\n is the end of line and carriage return or Enter)

But after solve that, there is a problem with the ConvertSkin.py in CreateEventList and CreateToDoList

The last line needs to be different: window.set("id", "Event List") and window.set("id", "Task List"). There can't be 3 different windows with the same id. (a bad copy/paste :P )

With this change, the 3rd skin works well, except the fact i need to rename those imaginev2\_small\_xxxxx.ini because Python error in today=ET.SubElement(calendar, "today"). calendar is None.

I hope this helps you.

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Well... no. The conversion didn't work. The xml file is corrupted, so that is why Rainlendar didn't list the xml file but yes the ini file.

I track the problem to:

```
...
YearBitmapName=
...
YearRasterizer=BITMAP
...
```

Year is a BITMAP, but no bitmap name is selected. According to the image in the site, there's no year in the calendar (or i didn't see it).

You need to delete the "BITMAP", or here is the xml file. (rename it to skin.xml)

.PY ERROR NOTE: I don't know why the output says "ERROR: Unknown align: AAAAAA". There are only 2 places where it says AAAAAA: "EventListFontColor" and "FontColor" in , none of them is an alignment.

Common issues:

There are a error occur when convertskin.py trying to convert "DaysWeekendFontColor=xxxxxx".

Work around:

Delete (or use # mark as comment) the line 343 in convertskin.py:

element = createFontElement(skin, getOption(config, section, "DaysWeekendFontColor"), "font.weekends")
```

Individual issues:

For "Dashboard FR" skin:

a) Please modify into and all other like that.

(note: into , into , into )

b) Please check all "color=xxxxxx" has 6 bits, because i found some has not 6 bits.

c) "MessageBoxBitmapName=" is no set, please setting.

For "Glassy" skin:

a) Please check all "color=xxxxxx" has 6 bits, because i found some has not 6 bits.

b) In section, it setting "Name=F»e", but it not support double-byte character when convert to xml. So, please reset it as single-byte character.

c) Can't convert "Command=!RainlendarQuit". So, please open skin.xml then modify the line 81 into ""
