This is beta version! It has not been tested.

Changes:

- o Changed the calendar selection to combo box. The "Allow multiple calendars" in advanced settings can be used to go back to the old way.
- o Added "w" and "h" attributes for the days element in the calendar which can be used to define the size of the day in the free layout.
- o Rainlendar_SetVariable() didn't work. Fixed.
- o Added a special calendar called "" to the included/excluded calendar list which can be used to show/hide events which do not belong to any calendar.
- o If the window fade duration is set to 0 the window is set immediately to opaque. This should help with the hidden windows on Linux.
- o Added an advanced option to show/hide the tooltip in the tray.
- o It's now possible to add a time offset for a calendar's events and tasks. This can be used e.g. for time zone adjustment.

About the SetVariable...

Well, it works. It looks like the problem is changing the Show_weekdays variable. Look this code:

Changing the value of test makes the year be visible/invisible. But this doesn't affect the weekdays. I tried setting 0 and "0", but is the same.

Could be that this doesn't work because Show_weekdays is in inside and year is inside directly?

I think I just discovered a little bug that probably isn't of relevance for most: If you install a language pack and then set categories, these categories are saved in the localized form (e.g. german "blau" instead of english "blue"). If you later switch back to english, these categories will not be read correctly and won't be displayed anymore (e.g. the entry is not colored blue despite having the category "blau"). Switching back to german solved the problem, though.

(I'm using beta 98, shadow 4 and google calendars on win 7 32bit if this is of any relevance)

Edit: One other thing: The german translation for "All following" is missing. It's "Alle Folgenden"

ics format isn't English, at least the content could be in another language, in your case German. I'm curious, why would you create an event in German and then change the app language to English?

But if you don't want to have troubles with the default categories (e.g. , , Birthday, Holiday) you could use the option "Store English category names" in Right click -> Options -> Advanced page -> General.
