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The transparency probably doesn't affect the memory usage very much. You can try to use some skin which uses as few bitmaps as possible. Removing all the plugins which you are not using might help too. There is a certain price you need to pay for a multiplatform application so I'm not sure how much less memory Rainlendar could take without a full reimplementaion as a native app for each operating system.

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I don't think disabling the plugins is something a normal user should be concerned about. If you want to do it you can just remove the .dll or .so file from the Rainlendar's plugins folder (on Windows and Linux; on Mac it's not possible to remove the plugins).
