How about having rainlendar look for key words within an entry and automatically putting on the appropriate icon?

Say if I have an entry that got the word "Birthday" in when Rainlendar sees this word it automatically puts the birthday icon when viewed ?

Also be nice i this could also be user defined as well so people can set up there own icon hook ups I guess u could call it

I don't have an iPhone, but i though (and i think) that Rainlendar works the the Category keyword of the ics format (plain text), so no icon is attached always. If the Category is "Birthday" then Rainlendar search for the appearance of this category and if it has an icon, it showed.

Can you set the category in the iPhone?

Could you use the last beta? In the latest betas Raqinlendar has an option to set the icon for a category (but icons inside the app)

And with an app sync? There is a page with app for sync, but i don't remember where.

I don't know if this exactly helps you.
