I am wondering if this is a limitation of the way webdev / apache authenticates or just a bug inside rainlendar it's self.

Either way, so cannot get two network calendars to work :(

Linux / Apache 2 Webdev module / Windows Client and you usually see the following in the Apache Error Log

```
user xxxxxxxx: authentication failure for "/xxxx/xxxxxx.ics": Password Mismatch
```

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Typically the issue is during initial Windows Startup but every now and then I get the odd failure..

Suggest maybe a delay of say 60 seconds before it polls during startup to help stop the network is not ready issue, the other 401 during updating also has me puzzled. Can we generate some kind of log for you rainy??
