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Currently testing x64 V2.8, but have had this problem other versions. Actually none have worked correctly updating tasks/Events from shared calendar on another networked PC. It is running x32 V2.8. Works exceptionally local, but when I try to update a calendar on 2nd PC, takes literally 60 seconds to update and almost immediately shows 'Not Responding' in Application Taskbar.

I am running Win 7 x64 6GB, QuadCore 6600 Processor, system with calendar database is Win XP Pro, SP3, 2GB.

Both systems are linked with 1GB Router Wired (has wireless capabilities), we are hard-wired though, both systems have Comodo Firewall & ESET Antivirus. Disabling both have had no affect!

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The problem is that reading the ics file in your system is really slow for some reason. If the file is empty there is not much to read so things work fine. It's really difficult for me to do anything about the problem without access to your system since I can't reproduce the problem myself.

What you can do is to keep your old events in a separate calendar and start using a new ics file for your current events. Setting up a ftp or http server to store the events would most likely help too.
