out of the sudden, Rainlendar is unable to sync with RTM anymore.

It says the authorization token is missing, although Rainlendar is listed as a service on the RTM website.

Also, it's impossible to create a new RTM calendar. When I try to do so, several messages appear with Error Code 0 (unkown error).

The RTM service was down for maintenance this night, but the website is working again now. Maybe hey changed something in their API ? My Android RTM app cann access the calendar.

Thanks for posting this, Kunena. I'm having the very same problem since last night. When I refresh Rainlendar I get two error messages: "The service is temporarily unavailable. Server returned result: (0) 0 Unknown error." and "Unable to parse the output."

I also get the same errors when I try to just add a new RTM calendar.

Like Kunena I've checked and Rainlendar is showing up under the "Services" tab in RTM.
