I'm now working on letting them switch after each other.

None -> Day -> Week -> Month -> None -> etc.

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I think this code would make what you want. The programming language used by Rainlendar is Lua. This code cycles between 4 values (0 to 3) and with each value hides/shows differents windows.  
But I'm not sure what will happen on each restart of the application.

  Rainlendar_HideWindow("Sidebar")
  Rainlendar_ShowWindow("Week View")
```

These are reversed :silly:  
But that's a matter of a quick change :)

Also I've tested the restart of rainlendar2, and:  
Rainlendar must load a bit now, like 1 sec  
Rainlendar displays the calendar you had before you terminated it.
