At this time, if you double click on an ICS file Rainlendar2 will try to import the event to an existent ICS file (at least in Windows if the association is setted). Maybe Rainy could add an option to this dialog to let the user copy instead of add.

I'm not sure if making a copy of the ics file is a good idea since that would create a new calendar every time you double click a file. But importing the events can be done by defining file association for the ics extension. Note that Rainlendar requires `-i` argument before the file name for the import to work.
