I need help with one issue:

I'm using a local .ics file that I share between different apps. But problem is that the new rainlendar doesn't auto refresh the content of the ics file, like the old rainlendar did.

also I saw in the old forum that this could be done with commandline in old rainlendar:
"C:\Program Files\Rainlendar\Rainlendar.exe" !RainlendarRefresh

If something similar could be done with commandline in the new version my problem is solved because then I could just make a scheduled task for this.

Otherwise, I will definitely upgrade to pro version when/if write support to google calendar is added!

And one more thing!

The forum Registration activation email gets trapped in the Gmail spam detection. That might be a problem for many users out there!
