Hello,

I have been using rainlendar for quite some time now and I would like to start using it in my company. We have a CRM application (vtiger crm) that our employees use to register events (calls, meetings etc) and tasks. The tasks support of our CRM is very weak and it takes to much time to register a task into it. But events should always be registered into the CRM.

I would like to give each of my employees a rainlendar license and let them register their tasks, but not their events into it. Is there any way to do this?

Another alternative would be to sync rainlendar with outlook and sync outlook with vtiger. Or even to sync vtiger with google calnedar and rainlendar with the google claendar, but that wouldn't allow tasks at all and would make it pretty useless
