
Crash when I try to add one Google Calendar

Rainlendar Pro 2.9 BETA build 105

When I try to add one Google Calendar, it crashes:

```
(rainlendar2:3194): GdkPixbuf-CRITICAL **: IA__gdk_pixbuf_loader_close: assertion `error == NULL || *error == NULL' failed
```

Violación de segmento (In english: Segment fault)

I go to Options > Calendars > Add... > Google Calendar > Next... In this moment it crashes.
Only it crashes with this type of calendar.
