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Hey there,

After a reboot following a system crash yesterday (damn Rainbow Six Vegas...), I realized that Rainlendar's position was reset (in the center instead of at the edge of the screen), and it wasn't showing any events or tasks.

Indeed, none of my settings, which I had taken great pains to optimize, were as they used to be - including the list of calendar files to be used!

However, a quick look at the ICS files shows that everything's still there apparently, so at least they haven't been corrupted.

Is there a way to retrieve my old settings? I'd really hate to go through that again...

Either way, looks like a good way to start into the new year... :unsure:

I'm on Windows XP, using Rainlendar2 Lite v2.0.1 (b28).

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Ok, happened again to me today with Rainlendar 2.0.2. This time it was not after a system crash. I've attached the config file (seems to be back to defaults) and here's what the log said:

The log gets overwritten every time Rainlendar is started so it doesn't show anything. This could happen if the the power is cut while the configs are being written but that shouldn't happen too often. The settings file is handled by the wxWidgets framework so I'm not exactly sure how thing work or if there is anything I can do about it.

Is this a common problem? Are there any other users who have experienced this?

As a temporary workaround, you might consider having RL create a backup of this file every other day or so.

Speaking of which though, some basic backup functionality would be really nice - and simple too: Once a day create a new timestamped folder in the backups dir (e.g. .../Rainlendar/backups/2007-01-07\_1824/) and copy the settings and calendar files there. If there are more than 10 folders, the oldest ones should be deleted. (Of course the backup interval and number of folders to retain might also be customizable, but that's not really needed for the most part.)

This would certainly give me some peace of mind now, because I'd be screwed if I ever lost all that data due to file corruption...

The config files in documents\_and\_settings were still there, but I had to copy them in the installation directory to have them "seen" by rainlendar - just as if I had a portable install! :blink:

I'd like to come back to the previous mode, because my backup tool searches in documents\_and\_settings.

How could I do that ?

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Rainlendar tries to load the config file from the installation folder first and if it's not there it uses the documents and settings folder instead. So, moving the rainlendar2.ini file to the C:/Documents and Settings/<yourname>/rainlendar2 folder should work. If it doesn't check the log for possible errors.
