This is beta version! It has not been tested.

Changes:

- o Mac: Importing files with foreign letters in the filename should work now.
- o Hidden windows are not drawn anymore to improve the performance.
- o Offline file didn't work with Google calendar unless the task list was read from the server too.
- o If the tray icon isn't selected for the skin the default icon is used instead. The icon can be disabled from the advanced options.
- o The mouse cursor changes correctly to hand when it is over a clikable link.
- o The skin.xml file is tried to read from the first subfolder inside the zip archive.
- o Google events which are marked as non-modifiable are set as read-only in Rainlendar.
- o The network calendars are not read immediately anymore if the poll duration has passed while the computer was suspended.
- o The due time was not stored properly to Remember The Milk's task list.
- o The next alarm for tasks which recurred last week day of the month was calculated incorrectly.
- o Changing the due date or time will reset the completed time for the task.
- o The tooltips are not shown anymore for items which are set hidden.
- o Added an option to select the settings file from backups if the startup has failed.
- o Added advanced option to remove the due time from the alarm window. This will also disable the alarm window from updating.
- o Added support for sub tasks. The tasks can be moved under other task when the list has custom sort order.
- o The position of the task in custom ordering is now written to the task itself.

Some serious bugs here

After upgrading, there is only the calendar shown.

No event- and todo-list overview anymore. When you choose not to hide empty items, then the overview appears.

However, I'm not able to edit *any* task or event because Rainlendar says its read-only. Even when I create a new event, I'm unable to edit it afterwards. No matter if I choose to have a local copy or not, or if the calendar entry is set to private or standard.

I'm running Windows 7, x64 on a german system with all the locales installed.

I'll change this so that it checks only the user name in the next build. The problem with the hidden windows will be fixed too. By the way, heres something that has been bothering me for quite some time now: I never really know if and when to install all the additional files, like - German.r2lang - Shadow4-Languages.r2skin-addon - Shadow4-Widgets.r2skin-addon For example: I just installed Rainlandar from scratch. Afterwards I upgraded to the latest beta by simply overwriting the files. Then a first start, everything looks good and also in my language. Then I installed the widgets to have the weather widget. After a restart *only* the weather was shown, and in english. Installation of "Shadow4-Languages.r2skin-addon" fixed it. But still, just the weather, nothing else anymore. Had to reactivate it in the extended skin-options. So, why not streamlining the whole process? It would be nice if Rainlendar would present a user-configured setup, and afterwards just download and install all the needed files by itself. And keep them upgraded.

I was wrong, Tooltips are working.

But you have to manually edit the .ini file. When you enable Tooltips in the extended options dialogue, it won't save. And after every change in configuration, it's resetted to "ShowTooltips=0".

I thought this bug was fixed long time ago.

Installation should really be streamlined. Spent about 2 hours of configuration work with the upgrade. I know, it's beta.

This is what I have done:

- 1. Install 2.81 pro
- 2. Upgrade to 2.9 b109 by simply overwriting the files
- 3. Install the widgets "Shadow4-Widgets.r2skin-addon"
- 4. Weather widget is in english.
- 5. Install the "Shadow4-Languages.r2skin-addon"
- 5. Realized that now only the weather is show, the calendar and everything else dissapeared.
- 6. Manually added calendar, event- and task overview again
- 7. The tooltips didn't show. Activating them in the extended options didn't work
- 8. Manually edit "rainlendar2.ini" and set "ShowTooltips=1"
- 9. Got it to work somehow.
- 10. Google calendar entries were flagged as "read-only". Solved by changing "@googlemail" to "@gmail"

As much as I like this great piece of software - but it's a little too much.

There are no plans to include the widget addon windows into Rainlendar's main distribution so you have to install it separately in the future too. However I probably could combine the language and widget addons into one package so you'd have to install just a single file.

The problem with the tooltips is caused by an incorrect translation in the German language file. I'll check if there has been updates since the last version.

Three:

You can see the image, event "test 01" and event "test 02" display on different day (alarm window), but they was setting on same day (eventlist window).

To me there isn't problem. Why do you take away a feature that it only fails some people and, moreover, it can be disabled in the options?

Because most people don't go disabling options if they have problems. Instead they send me email and I have to start guessing what could be wrong. And that takes a lot of time. If I can solve most of those problems by temporarily disabling a minor feature then that is what I'll do. Even if it might upset a handful of people. If you really need the feature you can continue to use the previous version until the issue gets fixed.

It seems that the new settings file is copied to the correct place but it's not taken into use. I'll fix that.

Alarm window (todolist window same) had not display task's due-time(like: 14:00 - 15:00 test1), even checked "Show alarm end time" option.

True. Currently the setting works with events only. I'll add it to tasks as well.

The new option "Show due time in alarm window", there had a "Show due to the event" option do the same work. And now, must both checked to done this work.

Yes, there is no need for two settings. I'll combine them in the next build.

You can see the image, event "test 01" and event "test 02" display on different day (alarm window), but they was setting on same day (eventlist window).

The timezone adjustment isn't applied when the all day event's target date is calculated so it might be shown on incorrect day. I'll fix that.
