Skin addons

The language addon has been integrated into the widget addon and to the Shadow4 skin. The updated widget addon can be downloaded from here: Shadow4-Widgets.r2skin-addon

Localization

The updated (not final) template file can be downloaded from here: rainlendar2.pot

This build is the release candidate so if there are no major issues found the next build will be the official release. That also means that now is the right time to update the languages so that they can be included into the installer. The language files can be uploaded to the Rainlendar's language page.

This is beta version! It has not been tested.

Changes:

- o The categories are shown in a drop down list with appearance. The old way can be enabled from advanced options ("Allow multiple categories").
- o Subtasks are now deleted also when deleting the parent from the editor.
- o Disabled the author check from the Google events since it sometimes caused valid events to be read-only.
- o Fixed multiple alarm support for Google Calendar. Rainlendar also reads only one alarm from Google for certain alert time.
- o If "Keep editor open until writing succeeds" was enabled the dialog was not closed when creating new events or tasks to Outlook.
- o Dragging an item which was changed at the same time could cause a crash.
- o Too large value for the time span in editor caused a crash. The maximum value is now limited to 60 (minutes).
- o The new subtask menu item is shown only for tasks which support subtasks.

Hope this can be fix also.

Is it possible to dismiss google calendar alarms, and have the calendar as read only?

Ive tested the final, beta 9 and beta 10 with a empty google calendar.

Problem: Dismiss ruins the reminder option on recurring events.

Tested like this:

Create a recurring event in google calendar with reminders like popup 10 min, email 1 hour and email 55 min.

Set it to start a couple of hours ahead.

Refresh rainlendar and exit it. Set pc clock ahead 2 hours and 15 minutes then restart rainlendar. After a refresh the recurring event reminders are popup 10 min and pop up 55 min.

Bu default Rainlendar always uses the pop up alert as the reminder but you can change this behavior from the "Google Calendar alarms" option in the calendar's settings.

Yes ive tried the "Google Calendar alarms" options.

Got the google error of modified too many events, so cant check for awhile

Did try default google methods, seemed to work somewhat. But if you have not set default calendar alarm it will delete every notification. Also custom made notification will be popup.

Anyways, if you dismiss 1 alarm window of a recurring event it will change all of them.

So basically would want to dismiss an alarm window without out it changes the entire event schedule.

The "Default Google Methods" should keep the existing alarms as they are but there seems to be a problem if the event has multiple alarms. In that case Rainlendar doesn't give any method for the different alarms so that the defaults would be used but when there are many of them Google Calendar doesn't know which is which so it will duplicate the alarms. I'll need to think about how/if this could be fixed.
