From the Rainlendar FAQ:

To install old skins you need to uncompress the skin into the Rainlendar's skins-folder. Make sure that no extra folders are created when you unzip the archive. There must be only one subfolder under the skins-folder where the skin's ini-file(s) are located. After you refresh the calendar the skin should appear in the skin list. If that doesn't happen check the Rainlendar's log file for possible errors.

From the VistaCal Readme:

First, install the included font, Segoe UI.

Then extract the "Vista Cal" folder to C:\Program Files\Rainlendar\Skins where C is the name of your hard drive.

This skin doesn't work very well with Rainlendar 2 because of all the fancy buttons. I'm working on a version that does, but won't have all the buttons because I don't know how to get buttons in Rainlendar 2.

Don't forget to restart Rainlendar; refreshing as the FAQ says doesn't always work.
