Is it possible to create a recurrence type which is not just every week, month, etc. but a certain time interval after completion. i.e. I need a reminder to contact a client 60 days from the last contact. If I am not able to make the contact for several days past the due date, it reschedules for 60 days past my actual contact date, not the planned date. So, all I have to do is acknowledge the task as completed, then it automatically resets itself for 60 days later.
