I have two problems:

1) (also present in 2.8) In the advanced option tab i have two "show icon in tray" and every time i access to options one of them is automatically checked to true, the second time i access to the option even the second one is automatically set to true and the icon become visible.

2) (new in 2.9) The opacity settings are not saved, the opacity don't change and if i re-open the options panel the opacity is to 100% even if i have tried to change it.
