ftp://www.mydomain.de/calendarfile.ics

I also tried it without www in front of the domain name.

It doesn't work, (error 200), username and pw are correct.

Another problem appeared:

Using shared cal via ftp on my desktop pc works fine.
Using the same settings on my laptop results in error:

Online: Result: (67) 530 User not logged in..

Retyping the password in the settings solves the problem, but after a reboot of the laptop the error pops up again. No

events, etc. are loaded.

This only happens on my laptop, not on the desktop. Both have XP Pro SP2 installed and Rainlendar 2.0.2
