The check box of weekday in recurrence tab will be increased, for example:

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Welcome to the forum, BloodLust.

I think I found the root of the problem. I will use the YYYY/MM/DD format.

To start on 2011/09/27 and change to 2011/11/29 you have 2 ways:

2011/09/27 (Tuesday) --> 2011/11/27 (Sunday) --> 2011/11/29 (Tuesday) or

2011/09/27 (Tuesday) --> 2011/09/29 (Thursday) --> 2011/11/29 (Tuesday)

These are the 2 days marked. When you change the date, Rainlendar thinks that you want to repeat the event on these weekdays too. It's not necessarily a bug, but in your case yes, could be considered as some kind of misunderstood from the app.

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I'd call it a bug but I'm not sure if there is anything that can be done about it. The problem is that the control triggers the date change event every time the month is changed instead only when day is selected. And I'm not sure if it's possible to separate the two situations in any way.

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
