This is beta version! It has not been tested.

Changes:

- o Changed the way *.wav files are played on Windows since the old way caused crashes with some 3rd party codec packs.
- o Added support for Google alarm methods and removed the "Google Calendar alarms" setting.
- o Increased the size of the calendar controls in the export dialog.
- o The recurrence days for weekly recurring events which defined the start date in local time could be set incorrectly.
- o Selecting a skin in the simple mode always added the alarm and tooltip windows even if the skin didn't support them.
- o Cancelling the date range dialog still opened the export file dialog when exporting events and tasks as comma separated values.
- o The calendar is selected automatically in the options if there is just one.
- o The SetVariable() will now store the new value to the settings file.
- o Exceptions for Google calendar events should work better now.
- o Cancelling or completing a recurring task disabled the next alarm instead just the current alarm.
- o Initial support for Toodledo.

Collect few problems :

1) Increased the size of the calendar controls in the export dialog. The dialog is not correct. See attached image.

2) Cancelling or completing a recurring task disabled the next alarm instead just the current alarm. This no fix. The problem is:

If set "Completed" from "Task editor", the alarm window will still pop-up, even the single-times task.

If set "Completed" from "Content Menu" or "Script", the alarm window will not display again, even the recurring task.

3) Subtasks will still exist if deleted parent item from "Manager" or from a script used Rainlendar_DeleteComponent().

4) The "Skin Format", in Help-file, wrote : , , , support format, but i can not use on them.

5) Can't find where to download Shadow4-Widgets.r2skin-addon v1.8 ? (someone need it that can working on 2.8.1)

1. I'll check if the size of the dialog could be increased some more.

2. Can you give an example for this? Changing the status from the dialog won't change the alarm but using the context menu should.

3. Yes. That has not been fixed yet.

4. I think they work only for the schedule type month calendars (i.e. one which draws the events separately to the days).

5. Unfortunately that seems to have been overwritten by the latest version. You can try to change the version in the skin-file and see if it works with the earlier version still.

I think there's a lot that could be done but your suggestion would be immediately useful to me. If I could also create tasks to add to a particular Toodledo folder from Rainlendar, that would multiply its usefulness.

If displaying tasks from particular folders is as easy as turning on/off the display of particular calendars (i.e. going into

settings and clicking the relevant options), that would be good enough for me.

2. Changing the status from the dialog won't change the alarm but using the context menu should. Is it mean that change the status from the dialog or using the context menu will got different results? But they both is called "Complete", so i think they should got the same results.

Example:

If now time is 02/11/2011 18:00,

Create 2 task: "task 1", "task 2" and the other set are all same.

Due time : 02/11/2011 18:15

Alarm : 5 minutes before the task is due.

Then change the status of task1 to 'Completed' from dialog,

and change the status of task2 to 'Completed' using context menu.

When time is coming at 18:10, the "task 1" will pop alarm window.

Changing the task status from the dialog is a bit problematic since you can also add new alarms from there too which has to stick no matter what the status is. I mean that you could add new alarm for a task which has completed status and the user probably would expect it to pop up.

I added the missing addon to the website. It's the same as 1.7 so I'm not sure if there are any problems with the 1.8 skin.

rainlendar still has issues adding recurring events with specific times to google calendar without messing up timezone information. any time you add a recurring event with an exact time through rainlendar, there is some weird conversion thing that happens, and google indicates a generic timezone "(GMT+00:00) GMT (no daylight saving)". In my case a weekly event set up in rainlendar as recurring every wed and thurs 10pm EST is interpreted by google as recurring weekly at 2am-4am thurs and fri. this then syncs to my other computers and phones incorrectly, therefore getting reminders at the wrong times and sometimes wrong days. Please fx this so I do not have to use desktop icalendar
