There is no such concept in Rainlendar as selected day. By default the event list shows the events for the next 7 days and the to do list shows all tasks which are not completed or don't have start date in the future.

The usual way to do it is to right-click or double-click a day, then you can see all events there (and edit them). You'll also notice icons for a day's events appear in the calendar, so you know where they are.

If you want to-do items to show up in the calendar too (so you can see where they are and click to edit them), go to Options -> Advanced, then enable "Show to-do items in calendar". This should allow you to do everything you want :)
