
Week View -Changing 'First Shown Hour' shifts Time

Hi,

I'm using the latest version of rainlendar and just found this odd behaviour:

I am using the Week View to show me an overview of upcoming events.
Per default the view shows 0 - 24 hours and a small line shows the current time.
After changing the first shown hour to 6 and the last to 22 the whole view is 3 h backshifted.
Now the view starts at 3 (instead of 6) and the current time indicator line is also at -3 h.

If you need more infos for reproducing this behaviour just give me a sign.

Welcome to forum, freezer.

I think, you have set the "Time item duration", that is a setting of "Week View", as "30 Minutes".

About "Day View" and "Week View", they both have a bug, when you changed the "First shown hour", you can only set the "Time item duration" as "60 Minutes".

Hope this help you.
