Looking for the setting that will expand the height of all day area. I have changed the height settings in the Options panel/Skins, and can change the height of the timed entries, but cannot seem to get the top portion to be taller.

The following is what my settings are at now:

- All day max height: 250
- Time Item duration: 60
- Time Item height: 30
- Week View height: 275
- Week View width: 625
- Scale: 100

I would like the All Day area to take up about 50% of the total height of the calendar.

There are some values hardcoded in the week view file which can't be changed.

According to the help file, there are 4 values:

eventminheight - The minimum height for an event in the all day item area.

eventmaxheight - The maximum height for an event in the all day item area.

maxheight - The maximum height of the all day event. If there are more events than would fit inside the area a scroll bar is shown.

preferredheight - The preferred height of the all day area. The height can grow if there are more events than would otherwise fit inside the area.

But you can only change the maxheight. Looks like the preferred height is overlapping the max height value.

If you know how, you can try editing the weekview.xml file.

- I found those values and modified the weekview.xml (located in the skins folder of Rainlendar program directory).
- Just to test I increased each value by 100 except the "eventminheight" value which was set at 35.
- It did not change anything.
