## Shared Outlook Calendar?

I have two questions, both relating to the same task I'm looking to accomplish.

1. Is Rainlendar able to access "shared calendars" (a calendar owned by a different person on the same network, but shared with my account) from an Exchange 2010 server? (We use Web access email so Outlook is never running.)
2. I haven't been able to tell from the features list... Does Rainlendar just add a new calendar window for Exchange calendars, or can automatic alerts be set on the Rainlendar side to provide default notifications for all events X minutes/days before?

Rainlendar does not support Exchange server directly so you must have Outlook installed on the computer to be able to see the appointments. All the data related to the Outlook events are kept in Outlook so it's not possible to define alerts in Rainlendar which are different than in the original event.
