Benn working on skinning and modding the weather widget from Shadow 4 and I've run across a weird behavior I'm hoping someone can explain.

I have several weather locations saved (in the skins.xml file). And everything worked great till I fired up my PC this morning. Now, when I select a few of the locations the app updates, but appears to hang with a "Refreshing..." message and N/A ? or all icons.

Like I say a few of these locations work fine, the ones I'm having problems with are the ones for Oakdale, Stockton and Los Angeles. I've verified the wc codes, and they seem to be correct. I have now errors in the Rainlendar log. And I've checked MSN Weather and they have reports for these cities displayed. I'm stumped.

Any help would be appreciated.

Seems to be "weather.msn.com" closed the support for RSS.

You can switch to use "GWeater.r2skin" (Google Weather

If you still wish to use MSN Weather, you can change string "weather.msn.com" to "weather.uk.msn.com", because "weather.uk.msn.com" seems still support RSS.
