This is beta version! It has not been tested.

Changes:

- o Added info text to the task editor which is shown in the recurrence tab if the due date is not set.
- o The info text also notifies if the alarm won't be shown because it is either ignored in the calendar or the skin lacks the alarm window.
- o Switching between events and tasks in the manager didn't update the menu items.
- o Changing relative start or end time on an event or task which didn't define the property moved the time to start of year 0.
- o Double click handler works in month view now too.
- o Process completed functionality is disabled for Google tasks.
- o Rainlendar\_ReadFile() doesn't convert the text to lowercase anymore.
- o The window specific settings dialog can be opened from the windows submenu.
- o The snooze time can be relative to the target time (i.e. event's start or task's due time). Relative times can be defined with 'r' postfix (e.g. "10r").
- o Added few predefined choices for the time and date formats in the advanced options.
- o Updated the 3rd party libraries: curl, lua, openssl, zlib
- o Created a workaround for a crash problem which happened on 64-bit Kubuntu when the event or todo dialog was closed.

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1. Yes. In the general section there is (in beta) a button to add the years in any category. If it's working right, you will see:

\* Birthday, Birthday (1), Birthday (2), Birthday (3), ... (for count)

\* Birthday, Birthday (1st), Birthday (2nd), Birthday (3rd), ... (for ordinal)

Of course, this only work for recurrent events.

2. Is the other way, the end of the recurrence, just like in the Events Dialog.

3. The "width of calendar list" is the tooltip for this option in "Shadow4 - Calendar List". The rest, I don't know. Looks like options for a window, but I can't see which one.

4. I don't understand this one. Where's the search addon?

I add one error: The option for calendar list width in Chromophore skin have a missing space, it's called "calendarlist\_width" instead of "calendar\_list\_width" (the same in xml file), and cannot be localized.

=> First of all, go Options...>>Advanced>>add a "Snooze times (mins)" like "5r" (note: must have "r"); then when alarm window popup, to select(change) the snooze time.

=> Options...>>Skins>>Categories...>>any one of category's setting.

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If an event starts e.g. 12:00 and the alarm pops up at 11:00 a normal snooze for 1 minute would show the alarm again at 11:01. If you select the "before target" snooze for 1 minute the alarm would be shown 11:59 (i.e. one minute before the target time 12:00).
