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Hi,

It seems that the day shown in the tray icon doesn't change until Rainlendar2 is restarted or windows is hibernated, that didn't happen in Rainlendar1.

- WindowsXP SP2
- Tested with several skins
- Rainlendar version 2.0.2 (b32), working only with ICalendar files

..personally I liked that feature in Rainlendar1 but now I'm never sure if the day shown is the correct day (I work a lot overnight..)

I use Rainlendar version 2.0.2 (b32) in a Notebook and always hibernat it for the next work day. Always that I resume my hibernated session, I have to close and open Rainlendar to have tray icon day updated.

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My timezone is UTC+2 but that shouldn't matter since Rainlendar is constantly checking if the computer's local date has changed.

So, even if you change the date manually the tray icon is not updated in your system? Does it update if you select Refresh from the context menu?

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Hi, yes it doesn't have anything to do with timezones, not very plausible idea but just to rule out things..

Today is 14th and the tray icon still shows '13', I've left my computer on all night.. The calendar "window" shows the correct day (marked with the red-circle - standard skin).. About your questions:

- If I select Refresh in the context menu nothing happens!
- If I change the date, forward or backward (tested with some minutes and some hours) and I wait like 15 seconds after just in case -> nothing happens.
- If I change the date to Monday 15th, one alarm windows shows the events for 'today' but the tray icon doesn't change.. I changed it to Saturday 13th and then again to Sunday 14th and still the tray icon is freed. I have to say that the red circle in the calendar was updated correctly each time.
- I've just tried to hibernate and de-hibernate windows and still nothing happens..
- Finally I re-started Rainlendar and now a beautiful '14' is shown in the tray icon..

No idea :-/

New findings:

-Now that I just restarted Rainlendar I tried to change the date of my laptop to the 15th, and then 14th and then 13th and then 14th again.. and now it works! the tray icon changed every time.. I'll see tonight.. but this is quite weird..

-Before I forgot to mention that Rainlendar1 never failed (in the same laptop and OS).. but tonight I'll run the two versions at the same time and see what happens..

After all those tests Rainlendar updated the tray icon properly for 5 days... (and it was the first time that worked since I installed it, almost one month ago..)

But today that stopped working again, the tray icon is stucked at 26, and it doesn't respond to the Refresh menu command..

I think this has to do with hibernation.. but it doesn't happen each time the laptop is hibernated so I don't know :S :S

I think windows is reporting the right day to Rainlendar because in any Calendar view the right current day is marked with that red circle..

Is there any difference in the code in getting the system date to update the calendar and to update the tray icon???

The code is the same but for some reason Windows doesn't change the tray icon if it's done immediately after the computer wakes up from hibernation. In the current implementation Rainlendar waits 15 secs before it updates the icon but I guess it still doesn't work always.

events are not refreshed

the problems relate to wakeup from Standby

(it makes you wonder too - how many people standby/hibernate and how many shutdown? poll!)

Rainlendar has to be shut down and opened up again on a daily basis - the problem is remembering to do this - what i really need is ... an event reminder program ;)
