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Close your running Rainlendar.

Unzip/Unpack the file in a temp folder and run Rainlendar from that folder.

It will use the same user files as the stable version (calendars, windows, etc.) but it won't touch anything except the configuration ini file, maybe.

This only works for 1 time. If you reboot, you will need again to close the stable and open the unpacked. To use this version permanently you will need to replace (or rename the stable folder) the stable files with those downloaded.

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Followed your advice and am now running beta version. The problem remains and a new event I created still does not trigger an alert - i set it for 30 June with 30 day notice, but didn't alert me.

I have a feeling the calendar file is corrupted somehow and that certain events are not triggering. I can't prove this though, but i have been using RL for years now and I've added and removed thousands of events so maybe over time something corrupted somewhere?

What's the next step?

If you have doubts about the calendar, create a new one called e.g. "test" and create in this new calendar a new event filled with anything with an alarm for 30 days before.

If the alarm window shows, then I would say to move one by one each event from the old calendar to the new (but this won't do anything) or recreate the events with trouble.

If the alarm doesn't show submit here the calendar file with the one event. But again, I don't think that here's the problem.

Are the events old? I mean, did you dismiss or snooze the event at least once?

Or search in the user folder (FAQ) for the .ics file, open it with a text editor, search for the problematic event (BEGIN:VEVENT ... END:VEVENT) and paste here ONLY this event (CHANGE ANY SUBJECT OR DESCRIPTION IF PRIVATE BEFORE). This will show if there's something wrong with the event data.

Oh well... I finally found (something) where's the problem and it's a mix between your events and Rainlendar config values.

Right click on a window -> Options... -> Advanced -> Alarm (is the last section) -> Hide from alarm after days

By default, this value is 7 days. test3, 4 and 5 alarm are more days away than this. Same as renamed text 1 and 2.

Edit: Also, you can remove the lines with X-RAINLENDAR-LASTALARMACK and X-MOZ-LASTACK. This will erase all info about previous alarms showed.

Aha!!!  
Problem solved, now alarms that 'quietly' disappeared from the calendar are showing up. I took it back 100 days and a few events that timed out past 7 days quietly dropped off the notifier, meaning I didn't know about those tasks after they disappeared.

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We'll it's also part my fault because I am using the event as a time driven task, and if I don't do it on time I click snooze for a few days and so on.

But now by putting 100 days there I effective have 3 months worth of 'snooze', right? Also solving, for example events that are 10 days ahead, with 25 days notice,  $25-10=15$ , so  $15>7$ , therefore no alert.
