I closed rainlendar2 and then created an empty file rainlendar2.ini in the exe directory:
I was asked if I want to import the individual ini files (e.g. todo.ini) when rainlendar2 starts, and turned out a lot of information is written onto the newly created rainlendar2.ini file

However, unfortunately... my network calendars settings, together with all the settings that I have configured are all lost altogether when rainlendar2 was started again after this ini file has been created...

Now I have deleted the ini file in fear... and restarted rainlendar2 to find the old settings together with my calendars have come back...
