Welcome to the forum, Chris.

I'm think I understand your problem.
Did you try using portable installation (see FAQ)? In this way, all the files are stored in the same place as the app, and the paths are always relative instead of absolute.

EDIT: I mean, install it portable on your Laptop, not using a USB stick.

I installed it "portable" on Dropbox Folder. There i don't see any option for relative path? When i have to select location of Default.ics, i just can choose absolute Path!?

If you don't define any path for the Default.ics file Rainlendar will try to load it from its settings folder (i.e. from the same place where the rainlendar2.ini file is located).

Usually you don't put the executable to the Dropbox folder but just the Default.ics file. Rainlendar is installed separately on each computer you use and configured to use the Default.ics file from the Dropbox folder. That way each computer can have its own settings which is useful e.g. if you need to have the calendar in different places on different computers.

Personally I just make a fresh installation on the other OS and point it to the same Google Calendar so I get the same events. For local events my suggestion is to share just the events file (e.g. via Dropbox or a shared folder) as sharing the settings between two OSes is probably not safe.
