This is beta version! It has not been tested.

Changes:

- o Some of the scripts got broken by the Lua 5.2 update.
- o The relative snooze to the target time wasn't updated correctly to the alarm window.
- o Added Rainlendar\_Backup and Rainlendar\_Restore to the Lua API. Backup can be done with a hotkey too.
- o Rainlendar\_DeleteComponent() deletes also the subtasks automatically. Same also happens if the task is deleted from the manager.
- o The start and end times are updated in the event/task editor now also if the time is entered manually.
- o If downloading the Google calendar fails because the authentication was expired Rainlendar will reauthenticate automatically.
- o Improved the error handling when importing events fails.
- o Yearly recurring events were not always shown on leap years.
- o Dragging a task in the schedule views did not work correctly.
