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## Windows immovable on Arch Linux

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First off I'm a fan of this programme.... Still, it usually has issues with an Arch Linux installation.

I've got a rather serious problem that sticks after a lot of tinkering (mainly installing various versions of various libraries) on my new Arch installation (on the VirtualBox emulator).

The problem is that all the three windows --to do, calendar and events-- simply cannot be moved. They are stacked on top of each other at the upper-left-hand-side of the screen, obscuring each other. I can't move any of them by mouse. I tried wmctrl, a command-line X window manipulator, but this did not do anything either.

So, I can't see more than a single window at a time, which I think you can guess how inconvenient.

I use a beta lite version, as the official one is known not to work with the latest version of Curl. However, the official version had exactly the same symptom when I worked it with an older version of Curl.

I guess some library's missing or something, because at the minute my system is very minimal... I'm running fluxbox as a Window manager, by the way.

I don't even know however where to start. Please advise how I could start debugging.

You can find it from `~/.rainlendar2/rainlendar2.ini` (or `~/.config/.rainlendar2/rainlendar2.ini`).

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Do you mean 'WindowPositionX/Y' variables under ? Well the values of different windows are already different anyway.

Any others you can tinker with, although the issue is not really with initialisation values. By the way, to add info, all the windows are 'on top', though I didn't set it that way

I looked at the log as well but there's nothing worth mentioning...

Below are the errors spat out when launched but perhaps it's nothing either

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That sounds like the window manager doesn't let Rainlendar to change its window positions. I don't know what could cause that since moving Rainlendar has worked just fine on all the Linux distros I've tried. The warnings at startup are not relevant as you would not be able to start the application if some library was missing.

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
