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## to do list problems

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Hi all,

I've been a very happy Rainlendar user for a couple of years, but I've only recently started using Todo lists.

They work great most of the time for basic tasks, but I've been having problems when I try to do something a bit more complicated:

1 - If I assign categories to a task, then the icon appears in the todo list for a few minutes, then it disappears and i get the same task repeated. For example, if I make a task, and call it 'phone home' and give it a category of 'calls', then i see a phone icon appear in front of the text, but a few minutes later (after a refresh?) the icon vanishes, and i see two 'phone home' entries in my todo list, one with an icon and one without. A few minutes later, i only see one entry, with no icon. Please see image below. Time goes from left to right.

2 - I also have a similar problem when i try to assign sub-tasks. They appear to be indented correctly in the list, but a few minutes later, i see two entries. For example, if I make a new task called 'phone calls', then add subtasks 'phone dad' and 'phone bank', then i see the tasks indented correctly for a few minutes, but soon they get duplicated. They also get duplicated in gmail too.

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Are you using Google Tasks? It doesn't support categories so the information will get cleared once the task is read back from the server. Make also sure that you are not trying to save the same task to multiple calendars as it will get duplicated.

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I've been struggling with this all day, and now it has got worse! :(

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Now ALL my tasks are being duplicated even if I don't assign categories or indent.

If I add a task through gmail or my phone, then it doesn't get duplicated.

I've even tried installing on another computer, but it happens there too, so I don't think it's a problem with my rainlendar settings.

I'm sure that I've only got one calendar (or does an offline copy count as two calendars)?

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\*edit\* I tried disabling offline copy, and that seems to solve the problem - but then I lose offline functionality.

I really can't understand what's going on. :unsure:

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Because, if create a task from gtask, is all normal,

So, this is my current workaround :

- a). Create a task (not sub-task).
- b). Refresh Rainlendar (If you had checked "keep offline copy", please refresh twice, and delete the redundant), which can be the source of the information into gtask.
- c). Then you can drag the task into subtasks,
- d). And can assign categories to the task (If you had checked "keep offline copy").

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Yes, it seems to be a bug (that is still not fixed :D)

I had the same problem with a calendar & separated tasks. Every task was duplicated by RL. Deactivating offline copy fixed the problem. I dont think it's so dramatically, because you can always download the database from google servers, not?

For my share i can say, that i would NEVER create a task, actualize and then delete the duplicate :D

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I ve got the same problem like Sagehorn. I don't want to disable the "keep-offline-copy mode". But when it is acitvated, all tasks I enter become duplicated. They are not just duplicated in Rainlendar, they are also duplicated at the Google Server.

Will this be fixed or is there a workaround?

Yes, this problem seems come again, from v2.11.1 b129.  
The workaround is (same with my previous posted):  
\* Refresh Rainlendar - twice, then delete the redundant items.  
And wait Rainy fix it.

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Don't know why that the duplicate issue seems never happened, even I go back to test b129 and b130, it's so strange.

But I found a new bug, also with Google Task :

- 1) set a task's due time as 2013-05-21 09:00 >> press "OK" >> wait few second, on to-do list, it will change as 2013-05-21 00:00
  - 2) open (edit) it >> no change any things >> press "OK" >> wait few second, on to-do list, it will change as 2013-05-20 00:00
  - 3) if redo step 2), will change again.

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Google Tasks doesn't support time but just date so it will reset to 00:00. It shouldn't change the date though. I'll check if I can find a reason for that.

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
