I have also tried to just extract all of the files into the skins folder (making sure that there are no sub-folders, just the files) and still they don't show.

That procedure is for Rainlendar2 skins only. Not for the old ones. You have to extract them in the Skins folder.

I have also tried to just extract all of the files into the skins folder (making sure that there are no sub-folders, just the files) and still they don't show. You do need a subfolder in the Skins folder. so:

Do not change the file extension to .r2skin for the old format skins. Skins which contain *.ini files use the old ini-format and they must be manually extracted to the Rainlendar's skins folder.

You need to have one subfolder in the skins folder where all the skin's files are extracted. The *.ini file must not be in the ../Rainlendar2/Skins folder but e.g. in ../Rainlendar2/Skins/MySkin folder.
