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I think it's because SubMenuName is in fact a variable, and you cannot use chinese characters for variable's names.

As it works now, I think it's the same as doing:  
SubMenuName = {Item1, Item2, Item3}  
Menu = {Item1, Item2, {SubMenuName}, Item3}

And if this is right, there's no way to change by user code.

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It's actually not a variable but a key in the table. The lua's short syntax for keys just doesn't allow foreign letters when defined this way but you can try to do it like this:

```
menu = { "green", "orange", {{"yellow", "blue", "red"}}}
```

While debugging this I noticed that the submenu needs to be wrapped inside another table which is unnecessary. I'll change this in the next build so you'll need to remove the middle { and } chars or you'll get an extra submenu.

Edit: Ok, it seem I can't enter foreign characters here either but those encoded numeric values are supposed to be chinese.
